I am engaged in taking pictures to express my love for this place and shooting different weather to elaborate my inner “weather”

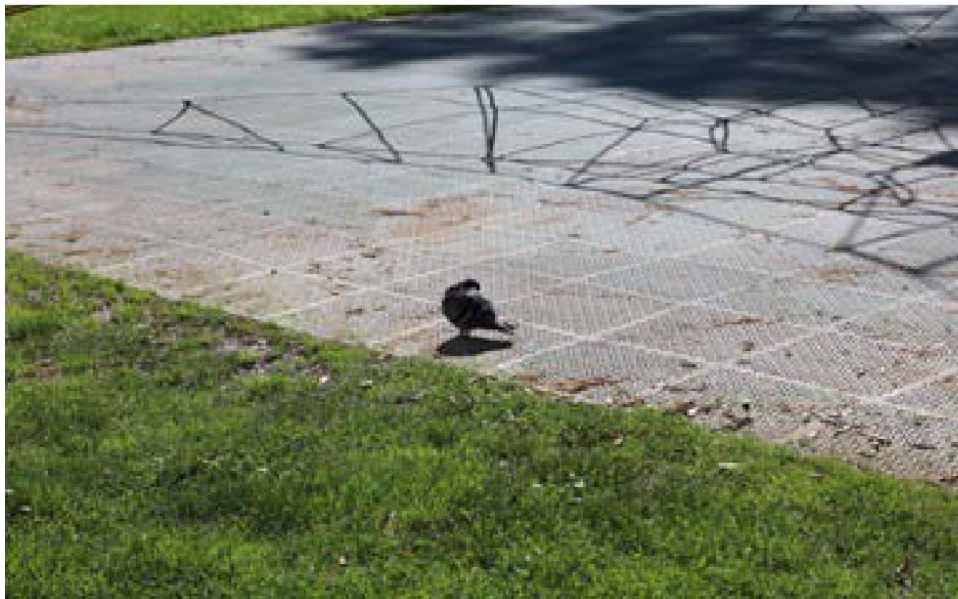


Plan

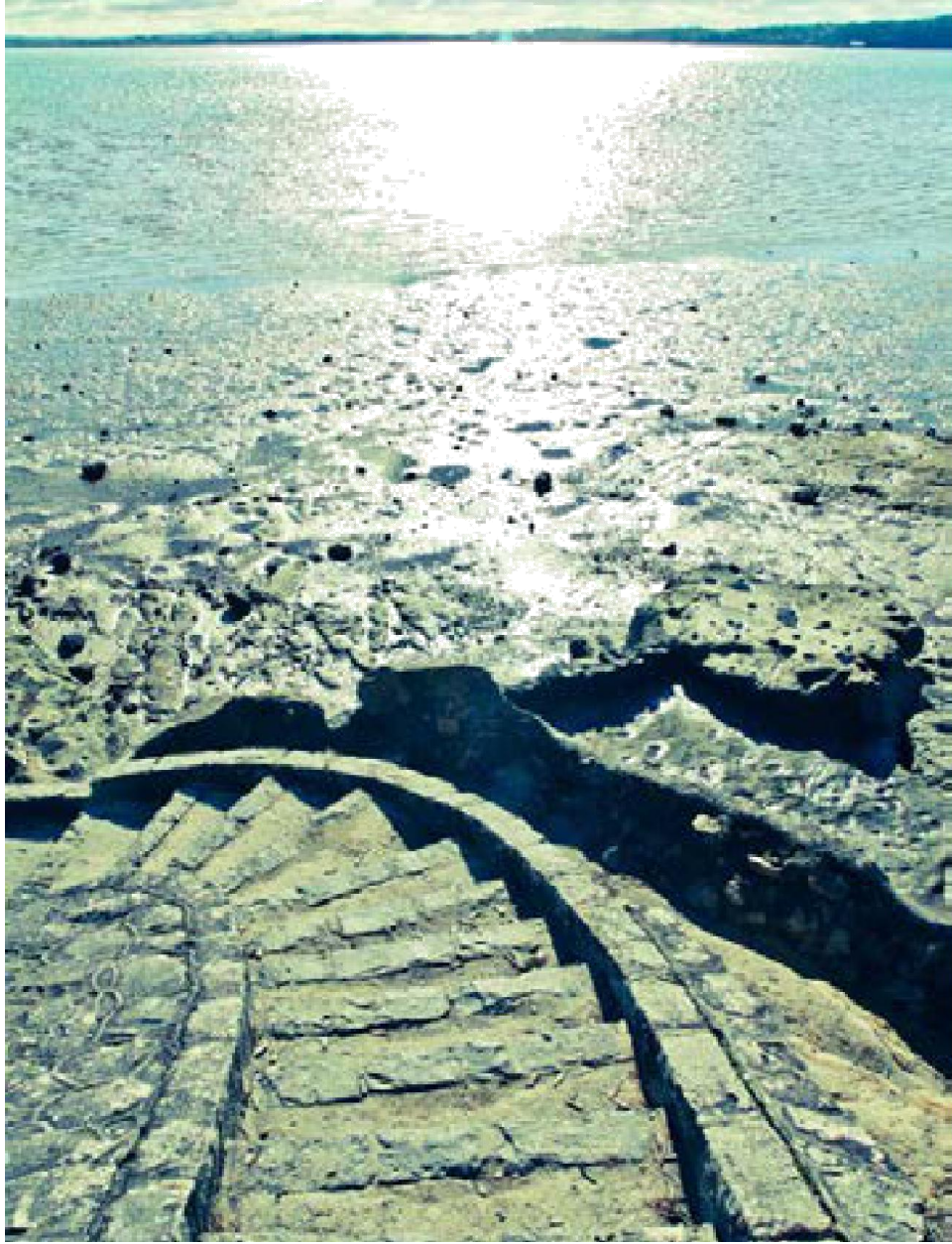


Figure 3. Coyle Park in Point Chevalier. By gather & hunt nz

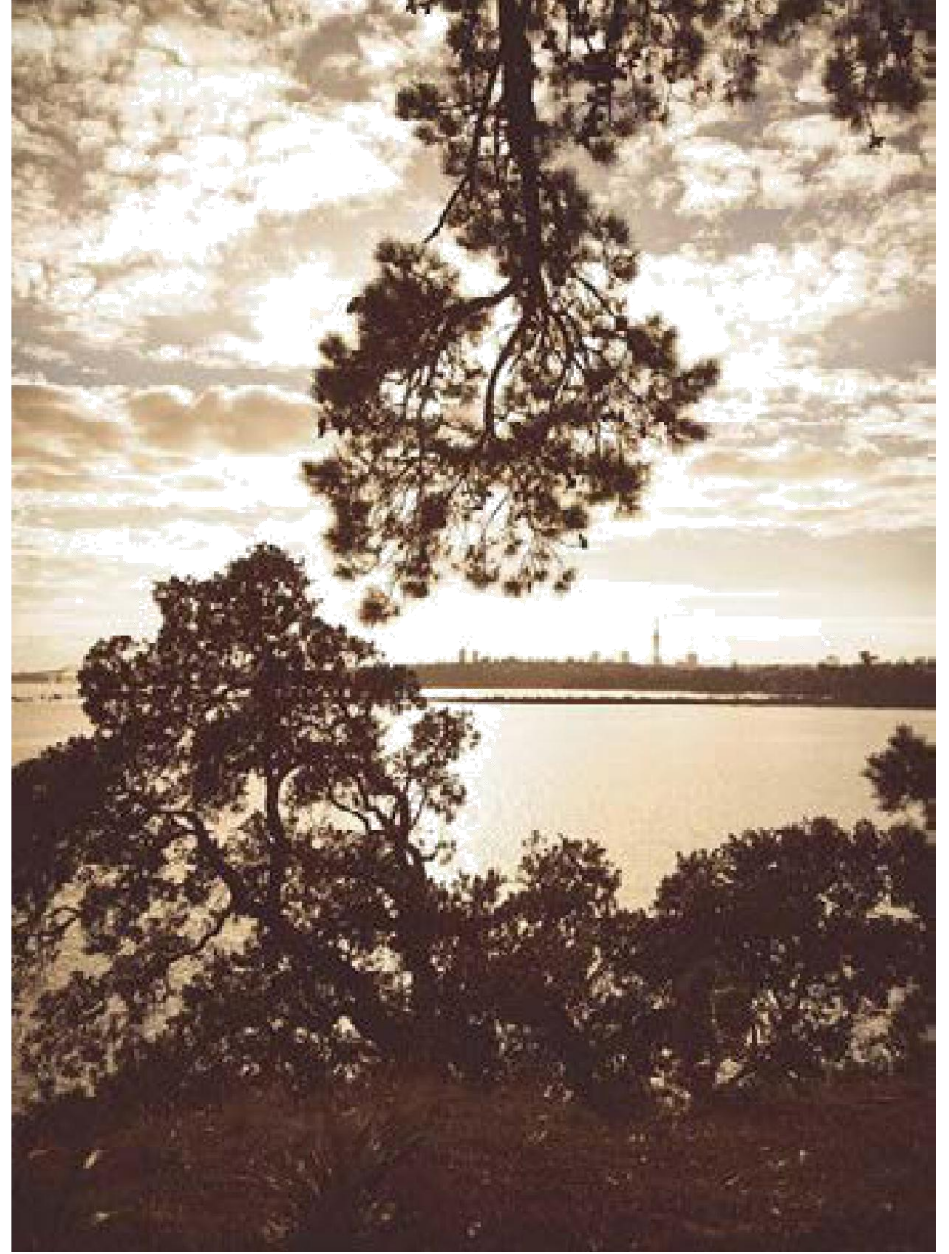


Figure 4. Pt Chevalier, Looking Citywards

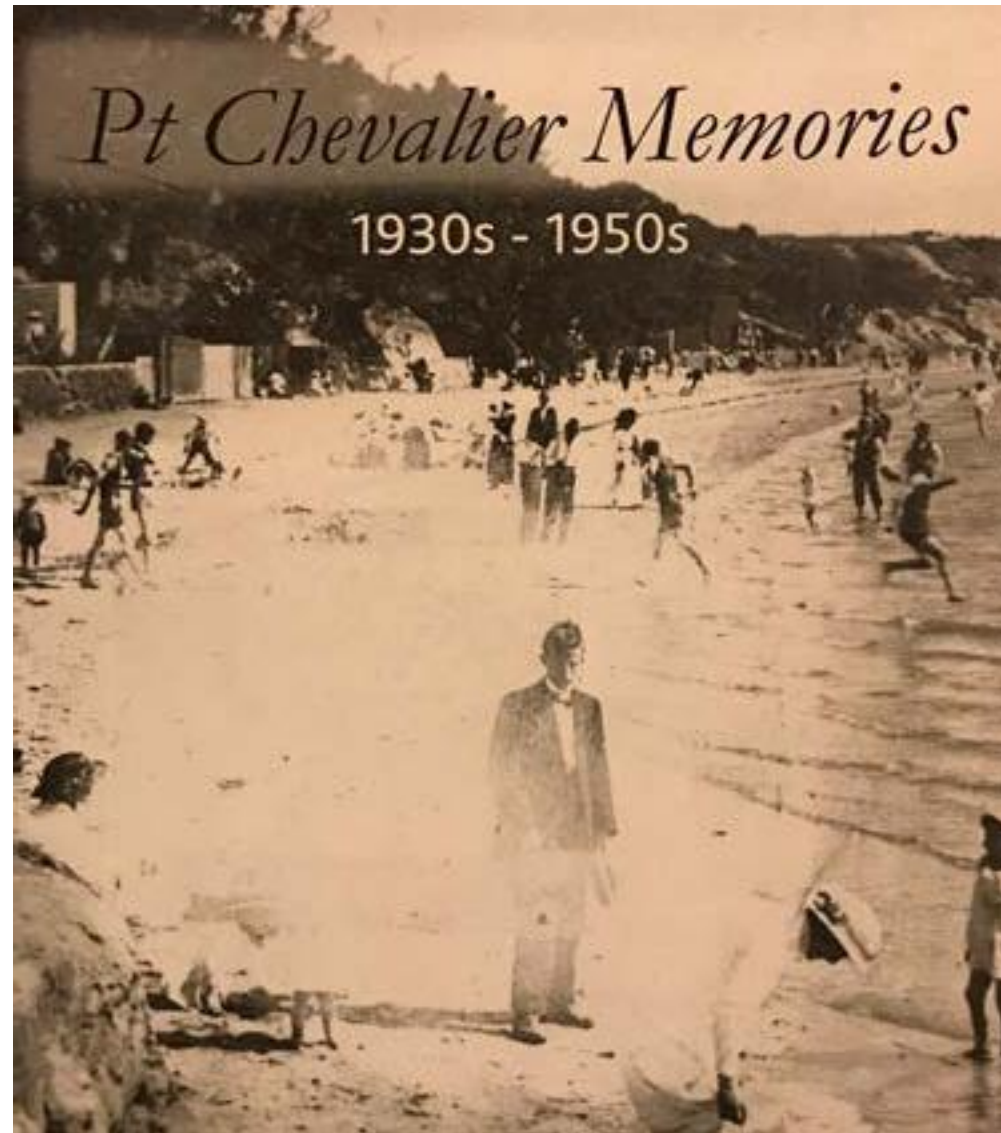
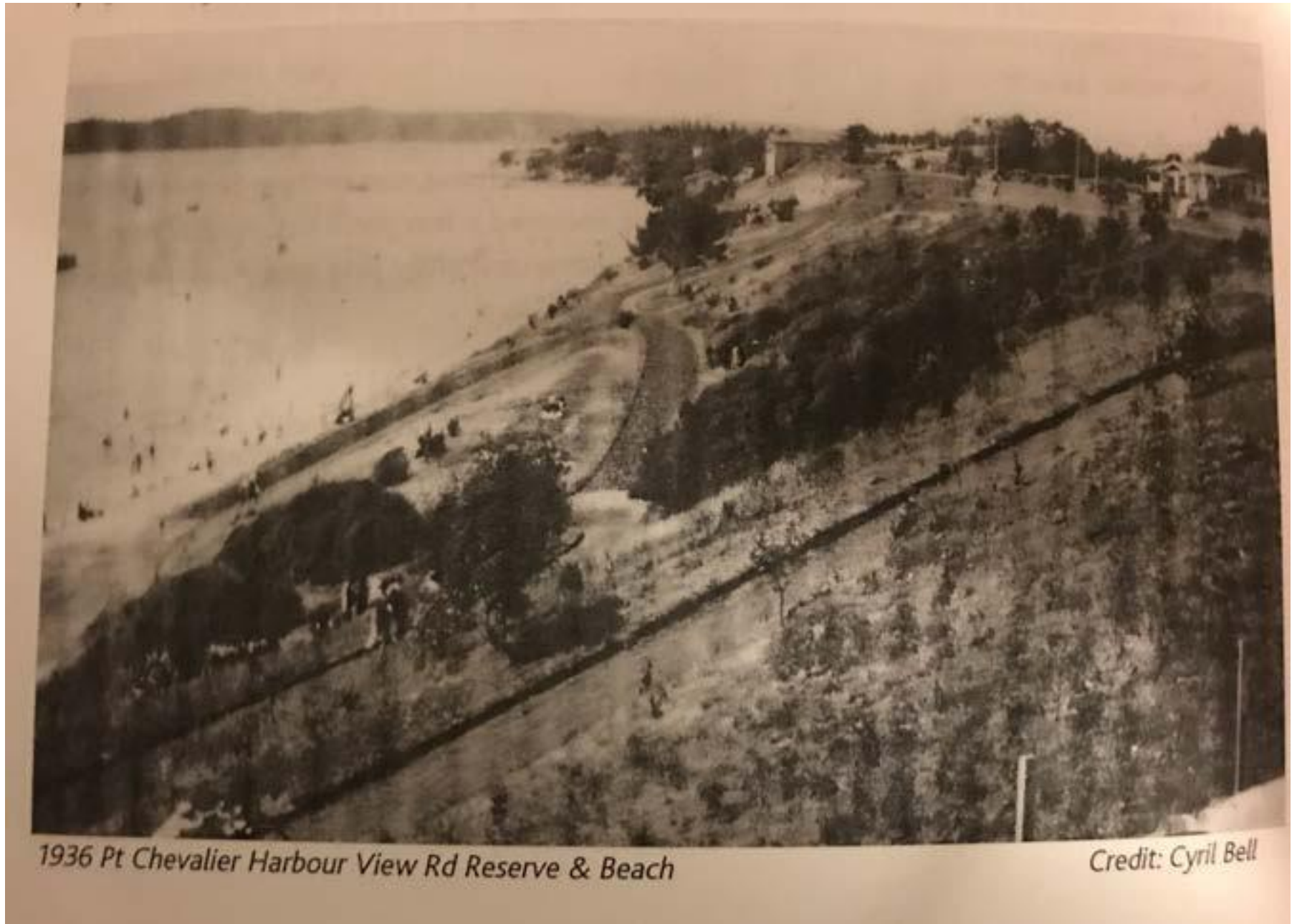


Figure 6. Pt Chevalier Memories (Point Chevalier Historical Society Inc, 2009, front page)
